HEADLICE

As I have mentioned on numerous occasions in Tintalk, many school children and their families come in contact with head lice. It is possible for anyone to get head lice from direct hair to hair contact with someone else who has head lice. As most lice do not cause itching problems, you may need to look carefully to find them. If found, lice and eggs must be treated with head lice products immediately and children are excluded from school until the day after treatment has commenced. Please conduct weekly checks on your children's hair to help us minimize this problem. Recently, there have been several cases of head lice throughout the school, so please be particularly vigilant at the moment.
